WHAT IS A ZONING ORDINANCE UPDATE?

The City of Dyersville adopted the Comprehensive Plan, *Plan Dyersville*, in July 2018. The plan is a policy document that sets out the vision for Dyersville in the next 15 to 20 years. A city's zoning ordinance is one, of several, tools to implement the Comprehensive Plan. The regulations of the Zoning Ordinance should align with the vision identified by the community in the Comprehensive Plan. Dyersville's current zoning ordinance was adopted in 1987. The Ordinance needs an update to meet the goals of the Comprehensive Plan and today's development practices.
