

Broadway Plan Advisory Committee (BPAC) Application
Conceptual Study – Broadway Boulevard from Crawford Street to Ash Street

Commitment: The BPAC plans to meet monthly during the course of the project to assist in the evaluation and refinement of conceptual planning design elements. Meetings will occur during the afternoon hours and will last approximately 1.5 hours. There will be a total of seven (7) Committee meetings and three (3) public meetings for you to attend. The BPAC will help to support recommendations to the City but is not a decision-making body and carries no authority. The Committee’s responsibility is to offer advisement to the City of Salina and act as project ambassadors for the corridor and throughout the community.
